This letter is to confirm that your pet is scheduled for surgery on_____.
Our surgery check in time in 7:00 a.m.-7:30 a.m. Enclosed you will find a surgery release /preanesthetic testing and an informed consent form. Please read and complete these forms and bring them with you when you drop your pet off for surgery. This will speed up your check in time greatly.

Preanesthetic blood work gives the doctor an inside look at your pet's vital organs. We are especially concerned with the health of the blood clotting system, liver, kidneys and heart. The liver and kidneys are the organs that help the body get rid of medications used during anesthesia. The electrocardiogram allows us to know that the heart is working properly before anesthesia. We strongly recommend completing these simple tests to help ensure the safety of your pet.

PRE-SURGERY CHECK LIST

1. **Remove all food after 6:00p.m. the night before your pet's procedure.**
2. **Remove water after 10:00 p.m. the night before your pet's procedure.**
3. If your pet has fleas or ticks, please spray your pet before coming to the clinic.
4. Give lots of extra pats and kisses.

The doctors and staff at Davis Boulevard Animal Clinic will do everything in our power to make sure your pet's procedure goes as planned. We will give analgesic medication to minimize any pain that might occur post-surgery.
